James Austin, who is buried at Corinth Cemetery in Cass County, is a Confederate soldier. He came here from Virginia after the Civil war ended. He is a survivor of the famous Pickett's Charge at Gettysburg, PA, on July 3,1863. He served in the 57th Virginia Regiment, one of the regiments of Armistead's Brigade in Pickett's Division. He is a survivor of the bloodiest single day of the Civil War, the Battle of Antietam, Sept. 17,1862.
