The funeral of the late Dr. T. Baldwin will occur this evening at 6 o'clock at the residence, Galveston, and will be conducted by the Masonic lodge and G. A. R. Interment will follow in the I. O. O. F. cemetery. He was a veteran of the civil and Mexican wars and achieved a record for bravery. He was one of the oldest Masons in the state, being a charter member of the Galveston lodge. Two sons survive to mourn the loss, Warren, of Little Rock, Arkansas, and Frank, who made his home with the deceased. The death was due to a complication of troubles incident to old age. Dr. Baldwin was in his eightieth year. His qualities as a man were such that he will long be enshrined in the hearts of a legion of friends in loving remembrance.
