

Mildred V. Baker

Private graveside services for Mildred V. Baker, 89, of Logansport, will be held in Mount Hope Cemetery.

She died Monday, Aug. 9, 2004, in Logansport Memorial Hospital.

Born April 22, 1915, in Cass County near Adamsboro, she was the daughter of Lora M. and Laura Bowyer Duckworth. She was married Jan. 6, 1940, in Albion, to Cleo Baker, who preceded in death. He had been a policeman.
