Joseph Grusenmeyer Dies of old Age At his Southside Home.

Joseph Grusenmeyer, aged 81, died at his home on the Southside yesterday morning of old age. He was one of the oldest residents of the city, having come here in 1852. He was born in Alsace and came to this country in 1843. He was a blacksmith by trade and kept a shop just across the river for more than twenty-five years. He had always been a highly respected and upright man, and had a host of friends. He was at one time a member of the city council and later was assessor of Eel township. He leaves a widow and four children - John, Sarah, Caroline, and Josephine, all of whom are married. The funeral will occur Saturday morning at 9 o'clock at St. Joseph church.
