Services for Eileen E. Kimener, 90, of Logansport, will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday in Gundrum Funeral Home.

She died at 3:15 p.m. Friday, Oct. 15, 2004, in Miller's Merry Manor.

Born Sept. 13, 1914, in Logansport, she was the daughter of Peter J. and Marie Hickey Kimener.

A 1933 graduate of Logansport High School, she earned a teaching certificate from Ball State University's Teacher's College in 1936. She completed the bachelor of science degree at Butler University in 1945 and finished her graduate studies at the University of Colorado.

Miss Kimener retired in 1968 after 32 years as a school teacher for the Logansport area schools. She began her elementary teaching career in Young America. After a year there, she taught two years at the old Hendricks School, another two years at Washington School and her remaining 26 years at Daniel Webster.

She was a member of the First Church of Christ Scientist, Delta Kappa Gamma Society, Indiana State Teachers Association, Cass County Teachers Association and the National Retired Teachers Association.

Surviving are one sister, Juanita M. Zabawa, of Logansport; three nephews, James Kimener, of Kokomo, Michael Zabawa, of Bloomington, and John Zabawa, of Evergreen, Colo.; one great-nephew; six great-nieces; two great-great-nephews and one great-great-niece.

One brother, Peter L. Kimener, preceded in death.
