

Deaths and Funerals

Thursday, April 6, 1922

Charles E. Leffert died last evening at 7 o'clock at his home 521 Helm Street aged forty-three years. His death resulted from a protracted illness. He is survived by his mother, Mrs. Mary Ann Leffert, a sister Mrs. Dan Killian and a brother George Leffert of this city and two brothers Harry Leffert and William L. Leffert of California.

Deceased was a veteran of the Spanish-American War, and served under Colonel Roosevelt with the Famous Rough Riders participating the battle of San Juan Hill.

Funeral of Charles E. Leffert will be held Saturday morning at 9 o'clock from the St. Bridget's Church conducted by Father Quinn. Burial will take place in St. Vincent Cemetery.

The Spanish-American War Veterans association will hold services this evening. All members are requested to meet at the G.A.R. Hall at 7 o'clock to attend in a body.
