

Dennis McManus

Dennis McMANUS, 85, Rochester, died at 4:31 a.m. Wednesday at R.L. Roudebush Veterans Administration Medical Center, Indianapolis.

Born in Washington Township, Cass County, to Dennis and Goldie STEWART McMANUS, he married Lydia Irene WIDNER Aug. 16, 1946 in Logansport. She died Jan. 16, 1947.

Mr. McManus was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and a recipient of the Purple Heart. He retired in 1978 from SUS Die Casting Co. He was a member of Fulton County Coonhunters Club.
