

Charles Michael 'Mike' Petrie

Services for Charles Michael "Mike" Petrie, 65, of Logansport, will be held at 10 a.m. Monday in All Saints Catholic Church.

He died at 9:52 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 5, 2005, in Logansport Memorial Hospital.

Born Sept. 11, 1939, in Logansport, he was the son of Charles E. and Mary E. Pifer Petrie.
