ENGINE KILLS A SWITCHMAN

Frank Reed, residing at 1510 Spear Street, a Wabash switchman in the yards at Detroit, Michigan, was killed Saturday morning while at work when run down by a switch engine. The remains were brought here this morning from Detroit and taken to his home on Spear street. The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon at 3 o'clock from the Market street M.E. church, conducted by Rev. Radcliffe. Deceased is the son of Mr. and Mrs. J. H. Reed of Spear street, and was the first of a family of eleven children to be taken. He is survived by his parents, widow, and three children.
