

**DORA ELIZABETH REESER
DIES AT FAMILY HOME
AFTER LENGTHLY ILLNESS.**

Mrs. Dora Elizabeth Reeser, 90, widow of Amos Melvin Reeser, died at 6:45 yesterday at her residence, 610 Bates street after a lingering illness.
