

CIRCUS MAN DEAD

Isaac Baker, Found Dead Sunday in Berth at Marion

Isaac Baker, 55, teamster with the Hagenbeck-Wallace circus, was found dead Sunday April 24 in his train berth at Marion. Death was due to a heart attack during the night, physicians said.

Baker was one of the circus employees assisting in the transportation of equipment from the local quarters to Marion on Saturday in preparation for the opening of the road season Monday. He had come to Peru from Elberon, Ga., the first week in April.

Surviving is the widow, Mrs. Florence Baker, Barrie, Vt., and a sister, Mrs. Maude Ducharme, also of Barrie.

Funeral services were held from the Allen mortuary Wednesday morning in charge of the Rev. R. E. Tunmer, Presbyterian pastor. Burial was in Mt. Hope cemetery.
