Mrs Ida May BRINDLE, 73, 217 East Ninth, widow of Ruben BRINDLE and lifelong resident of Peru, died at 2:15 a.m. Friday (16 Dec 1949) at her residence, of complications.

She was ill 16 months.

Mrs. BRINDLE was a member of the First Christian Church.

She was born Aug. 20, 1876, in Whitley County, Indiana, the daughter of Patrick and Emma (JACKSON) RAYMER. She married Ruben BRINDLE in 1904. He preceded her in death in 1938.
