

Peru Daily Tribune March 2, 1928 issue:

Mary Maria Burdine, 68, wife of John Burdine died at her home at 4:50 o'clock this morning after an illness of two weeks from a complication of diseases. The funeral services will be held at 10 o'clock Monday morning from the W. S. Drake chapel on East sixth street and interment will be made in Mount Hope cemetery.

The deceased was a native of Ohio and was born at Antwerp. She was united in marriage with John Burdine at Paulding, Ohio, August 5, 1875. They moved to Peru from Ohio 21 years ago. The husband, seven children, two brothers and two sisters survive. The children are: George Burdine of Muncie; Harry Burdine of Centuria, Wis.; William Burdine of Peru; Bert Burdine of Iron Mountain, Michigan; Clayton Burdine of Peru; Minnie Snyder of Peru; and Opal Beal of Mishawaka. the brothers and sisters are Eli Munson of Battle Creek Michigan; Theodor Munson of Fort Wayne; Mrs. Effie Snyder of Fort Wayne; and Mrs. Jack Shepherd of Indianapolis.
