ELIZA JANE MORRIS

Mrs. Eliza Jane Morris, a lifelong resident of Peru and widow of Alvin Morris, died at 7:45 p.m. Thursday at her home, 57 East Warren Street. Mrs. Morris had been ill only a few hours, her death being attributed to a stroke of apoplexy.

Mrs. Morris was the daughter of William and Rachel Ingel and was born August 26, 1852, being 88 years, four months and seven days old at the time of her death. In 1870 she was united in marriage with Alvin Morris, former Peru policeman, who died 37 years ago. Mr. Morris was a charter member of the Peru Elks Lodge and was also a Civil War veteran.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Della Neusbaum, 57 East Warren St.; a brother, Bradford Ingle, Indianapolis; a sister, Mrs. May Wilkinson, Indianapolis; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. The grandchildren are: Mrs. Marshall Foust, Amboy; Mrs. Maurice Linkenhelt, Rich Valley; Miss Josephine Morris, Peru; Mrs. Woody Hudson [Dorothy Morris], Kokomo; Miss Mary Ruth Morris, Peru; and Robert Morris, Peru. Great-grandchildren are: Tracy Lee Foust, Robert Morris and Ann Jean Morris. Two other children, Alvin and Arthur Morris are deceased. The body will be taken from the Drake Funeral Home to the late residence Saturday afternoon at 2:00 and friends may call there. Funeral services will be held from the Drake Funeral Home Monday afternoon at 2:00, with the Rev. V.L. Clear officiating and interment will be made in Mount Hope Cemetery.
